WHEREAS King County provides public transportation fare discounts to seniors, disabled and youth riders, and

WHEREAS King County is committed to providing equitable opportunities for people from all areas of King County to access the public transportation system, and

WHEREAS the King County council passed Motion 13746 on October 8, 2012, requesting the establishment of an advisory committee to assist in the review and development of new King County public transportation fare options for low-income persons, and

WHEREAS the executive is requested to convene the advisory committee by February 1, 2013, and

WHEREAS recommendations to the council by the advisory committee should be transmitted by July 1, 2013;
