A MOTION confirming the appointment of Linh Thai, who lives in council district 2, as the representative of the Vietnamese-speaking community to the King County citizen's elections oversight committee.

WHEREAS, in Ordinances 14711 and 15157 the metropolitan King County council established citizens' election oversight committees to review the conduct of elections in King County, to identify problems and to make recommendations, and

WHEREAS, those committees have consistently provided invaluable service to county voters and county government, and

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 15453 the council established a new citizens' elections oversight committee and adopted criteria for membership on the committee, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 17273 established a membership position on the citizens' elections oversight committee to represent the Vietnamese-speaking community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The appointment of Linh Thai to the King County citizens' elections oversight committee, as the representative of the Vietnamese-speaking community for a term term to expire on December 31, 2017, is hereby confirmed.
