BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated by and between King County and Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Council 2, Local 2084SC-S (Superior Court -

Supervisors (Wages Only)) representing employees in King County superior court and attached hereto is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.
