AN ORDINANCE adopting Growth Management Planning Council Motion 13-1 and ratifying

Motion 13-1 for unincorporated King County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings:

- A. King County Countywide Planning Policy DP-31 allows for designation of new Urban Centers.
- B. The city of Issaquah has demonstrated that the Central Issaquah Urban Core meets the criteria listed in Policy DP-3.
- C. On May 29, 2013, the city of Issaquah briefed the Growth Management Planning Council on the proposal to designate the Central Issaquah Urban Core as an Urban Center.
- D. On September 25, 2013, the Growth Management Planning Council adopted Motion 13-1 amending the urban Growth Area map in the 2012 King County Countywide Planning Policies to add the Central Issaquah Urban Core as an Urban Center.
