



public hearing that has been noticed, and

WHEREAS, to avoid any potential claim that, by engaging in this public participation process, the county might be in violation Article I, Section 11 of the Washington state Constitution, which prohibits the use of governmental money or property in the support of religion, the school is making a donation in the amount of \$6,500 dollars which is a reasonable estimate of the cost of publishing notice and of staff time devoted to the public participation process as set forth in the school's letter of May 6, 2014, and

WHEREAS, under K.C.C. 2.80.010 donations of more than two thousand dollars must be accepted on behalf of King County by motion, and

WHEREAS, the school has stated that the purpose of the donation is to reimburse the council's costs of publication and staff time for the public participation process and that remainder, if any be applied, at the Council's discretion;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County council accepts the donation of \$6,500 dollars by the Bear Creek School for the purposes set forth in the school's letter of May 6, 2014.
