A MOTION acknowledging receipt of a report describing practices related to confinement of juveniles in compliance with Ordinance 18409, Section 55, as amended by Ordinance 18766, Section 23, Proviso P12.

WHEREAS, a 2017-2018 supplemental budget ordinance, Ordinance 18766, Section 23, Proviso P12, which amended the 2017-2018 Biennial Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 18409, Section 55, requires the executive to transmit a report describing practices related to confinement of juveniles, and a motion acknowledging receipt of the report, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 18766, Section 23, Proviso P12, provides that \$100,000 shall not be expended or encumbered until the first report required by the proviso is acknowledged, and the motion acknowledging receipt of this report is passed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
