WHEREAS, K.C.C. 2.16.025.B.8.i. requires that a biennial report about benefits achieved from technology projects and a motion be transmitted by April 30 in odd-numbered years, and

WHEREAS, the biennial report includes a compilation of benefit achievement plans for all recently-completed projects with outstanding benefit achievement plans, as well as benefit achievement plans for all projects either in progress or newly approved, and

WHEREAS, the biennial report contains a summary section that describes any lessons learned about defining and reporting on benefits for technology projects and provides an analysis of the benefits achieved in 2017-2018 for the overall project portfolio;
