WHEREAS, the 2019-2020 Biennial Budget, Ordinance 18835, Section 95, Proviso P2, requires the executive to transmit a plan to achieve the United States Department of Health and Human Services's Healthy

People 2020 target of eighty percent human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine series completion of county residents between eleven and seventeen years old, and

WHEREAS, the plan includes the following:

1. Funding options that evaluate both existing and new revenue sources;
2. Strategies to collaborate and coordinate with various stakeholders including schools, churches, health care providers, hospitals, community organizations, local jurisdictions and state agencies;
3. Identification of potential challenges and plans to mitigate those challenges; and
4. A timeline for achieving eighty percent vaccination of county residents that align with Healthy People 2020 objectives, and

WHEREAS, the executive is further required to submit a motion that acknowledges receipt of the plan by June 30, 2019;
