- b. County procurement policies;
- c. Use in water quality, habitat and site rehabilitation projects;
- d. Use in county or private development projects; and
- e. Subsidies for agricultural or other uses.

2. A set of recommendations that the county could pilot to use compost produced from the county's organics stream, cost estimates for those recommendations, any barriers to the use of the compost and options to overcome those barriers, and
