WHEREAS, Ordinance 18835, Section 19, Proviso P4, provides that \$100,000 shall not be expended or

encumbered until the executive transmits the feasibility study required by the proviso and a motion

acknowledging receipt of the study, and the motion acknowledging receipt of the study is passed, and

WHEREAS, the executive is further required to submit the feasibility study and the motion that

acknowledges receipt of the study by October 4, 2019;
