WHEREAS, if the council does not pass a motion acknowledging receipt of the report by April 30,
2021, then, unless provided authority through an ordinance to renew the 2018 regional animal services

interlocal agreement for a second five-year term, the executive must give notice of its intent to opt out of the interlocal agreement;
