AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive to execute an							

interlocal agreement with King County Flood Control Zone District.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. Since January 1, 2008, King County has provided a full range of services to and for the King

County Flood Control Zone District under interlocal agreements between the district and King

County.

- 2. The district desires to have King County continue to perform those services.
- 3. The current interlocal agreement between the district and King County is set to expire on

December 31, 2021.

- 4. The district desires to execute a new interlocal agreement with King County and to authorize
- King County to provide flood protection services through January 1, 2027, with an option to

extend for an additional two years.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute an

interlocal agreement, substantial in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, with the King County Flood

Control Zone District for the provision of services.
