AN ORDINANCE approving a franchise for the Northshore Utility District to construct, operate and maintain a water and sewer system in council districts 1 and 11 and authorizing the executive to execute the franchise agreement.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 1. The Northshore Utility District has filed an application for a franchise in council districts 1 and 11 to construct, operate and maintain a water and sewer system to serve single family residences, industrial and commercial properties in accordance with RCW 36.55.010 and K.C.C. chapter 6.27.
- 2. Northshore Utility District 2000 Water System and 2000 Wastewater comprehensive plans

were approved by King County council on September 12, 2001 under Ordinance No. 14192.

3. The application has been referred to the relevant county departments for review.

4. The King County executive has recommended approval of the franchise.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The granting of a franchise to the Northshore Utility District to construct, operate and

maintain a water and sewer system within King County is hereby approved. The King County executive is

authorized to enter into and execute the water and sewer system franchise, which by this reference is fully

incorporated herein. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the

county.

SECTION 2. If within thirty days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to

sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the

rights and privileges granted herein shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
