AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the hearing examiner and approving, subject to conditions, upon the application of Cougar Ridge, to amend King County Title 21A, as amended, by amending the zoning map thereof, reclassifying certain property from R-1P to R-1, designated development and environmental services file no. L02TY401.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the June 3, 2002, report and recommendation of the hearing examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on July 24, 2002, upon the application of Cougar Ridge to reclassify certain property described in development and environmental services file no. L02TY401.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the hearing examiner to reclassify the subject property from R-1P to R-1 is hereby adopted, subject to conditions. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the land use services division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
