**Title:** AN ORDINANCE providing for the submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on November 8, 2005, of a proposition to provide regional health and human services to residents of King County by authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation contained in chapter 84.55 RCW, for a consecutive six year period at a rate of not more than \$0.05 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation, for the purpose of providing funding to enable the provision of health and human services such as housing, mental health counseling, substance abuse prevention and treatment, employment assistance and other essential regional health and human services for residents of King County and establishing two county citizen oversight boards to review and report on expenditures of levy proceeds, contingent on voter approval of the levy.
