AN ORDINANCE relating to the board of appeals and equalization and

amending policy regarding compensation for board members and hearing

examiners; and amending Ordinance 6444, Section 5, as amended, and K.C.C.

2.34.050.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Ordinance 6444, Section 5, as amended, and K.C.C. 2.34.050 are each hereby amended as follows:

Compensation.

A. For each six-hour day devoted to official work of the board, each member and each hearing examiner employed by the board thereof shall receive a per diem allowance of two hundred <u>fifty</u> dollars except

that a per diem allowance of one hundred ((twenty-five)) <u>fifty</u> dollars shall be paid for official board work of more than four hours but less than six hours.

B. Members of the board assigned parking stalls shall pay parking fees as provided for in K.C.C. chapter 3.32 unless exempted from payment by ordinance.
