BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The memoranda of agreement negotiated by and between King County and the various Unions representing employees of King County, which are Attachments A and B to this ordinance, are hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of each agreement shall be effective upon full and final ratification of the parties, and shall expire pursuant to the terms of individual agreements.
