WHEREAS, the 2022-2023 Biennial Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 19546, Section 35, Proviso P1, states that \$400,000 shall not be expended or encumbered until the executive transmits a report describing the new protection order process as required in Proviso P1.A., a report evaluating the protection order pilot program as required in Proviso P1.B., and a motion acknowledging receipt of each report and both motions are passed by the council, and

WHEREAS, the executive has deemed it appropriate for superior court to transmit the report outlined in Proviso P1.B. directly to the council, and
