AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive to execute an interlocal agreement with the city of Tukwila for the King County road services

division to provide road-related services on an "as-requested" basis.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 1. The city of Tukwila has the legal responsibility to repair and maintain the public roads and traffic devices within its service area.
- 2. The city of Tukwila requests that the King County road services division provide road-related services on an as-requested basis.
- 3. King County road services division is willing and able to perform such services for the city of

Tukwila.

- 4. The parties can achieve cost savings and benefits that are in the public's interest by having King County road services division provide such services that the city of Tukwila requests, at the city of Tukwila's expense.
- 5. Chapter 39.34 RCW authorizes the counties to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement such as Attachment A to this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The county executive is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal agreement with the city of Tukwila, substantially in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, to provide road-related services on an "as requested" basis.
