



RapidRide lines opened or planned for implementation between 2020 and 2031;

2. A description of the efforts the Metro transit department has taken to respond to the recommendations contained in the July 18, 2023, King County auditor's office audit entitled Metro Transit: Strengthening Data, Communication, and Continuous Improvement Processes Could Help Reduce Project Delays, including how the Metro transit department's responses to the audit recommendations could expedite the development of planned RapidRide lines;

3. A description of any efforts the Metro transit department has taken to change its capital delivery processes based on best practices for capital delivery identified or implemented by peer agencies or based on the Metro transit department's past experiences with partner jurisdictions and agencies that own and operate the right-of-way on which RapidRide lines run; and

4. Any legislation necessary to expedite Metro transit department capital delivery processes, including any legislation necessary to expedite the development of planned RapidRide lines;
