A MOTION adopting the 2002 work program for the labor, operations and

technology committee.

WHEREAS, the labor, operations and technology committee is charged with considering and making

policy recommendations relating to the management organizational structure, customer service, efficiency, cost

effectiveness and performance of county departments, and

WHEREAS, the committee is also charged with considering and making recommendations relating to

the annual audit program, and

WHEREAS, the council designated the committee as the labor implementation committee responsible for implementing labor policy, and WHEREAS, the committee is charged with considering and making recommendations on labor agreements and municipal services contracts, and

WHEREAS, the committee is also charged with considering and making policy recommendations

relating to information technology, cable communication and telecommunications, and

WHEREAS, King County is experiencing unprecedented, continuing shortfalls in the current expense

fund, and

WHEREAS, the committee has, therefore, developed a work plan for 2002 to facilitate its review of

policy options and development of policy recommendations to assist in cost effective solutions to these on-

going financial problems, and

WHEREAS, the committee is seeking full council involvement in and support for its work program;
