AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle-King County department of public health; establishing fees under the authority of K.C.C. 2.99.030 for certain medical examiner documents to align revenues to associated costs; and amending Ordinance 15952, Section 2, and K.C.C. 2.24.135 and Ordinance 11137, Section 1 (part), as amended, and K.C.C. 4.88.010 and adding a new section to K.C.C. Title 4.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes in fees for copies of medical examiner autopsy reports and determinations.

B. The fees are imposed under K.C.C. 2.99.030.B.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 11137, Section 1 (part), as amended, and K.C.C. 4.88.010 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

((Effective January 1, 1994, the following fees are added to the King County code and are hereby established.)) A. Any person, agent or company who requests and receives a copy of an autopsy report in accordance with RCW 68.50.105 shall be charged a fee of ((forty)) fifty dollars.

- B. Any person, agent or company who requests and receives a copy of a determination shall be charged a fee of twenty dollars.
- C. Revenues generated by the autopsy reports and determinations fee shall be expended to support the King County medical examiner's office.

SECTION 3. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2011.
